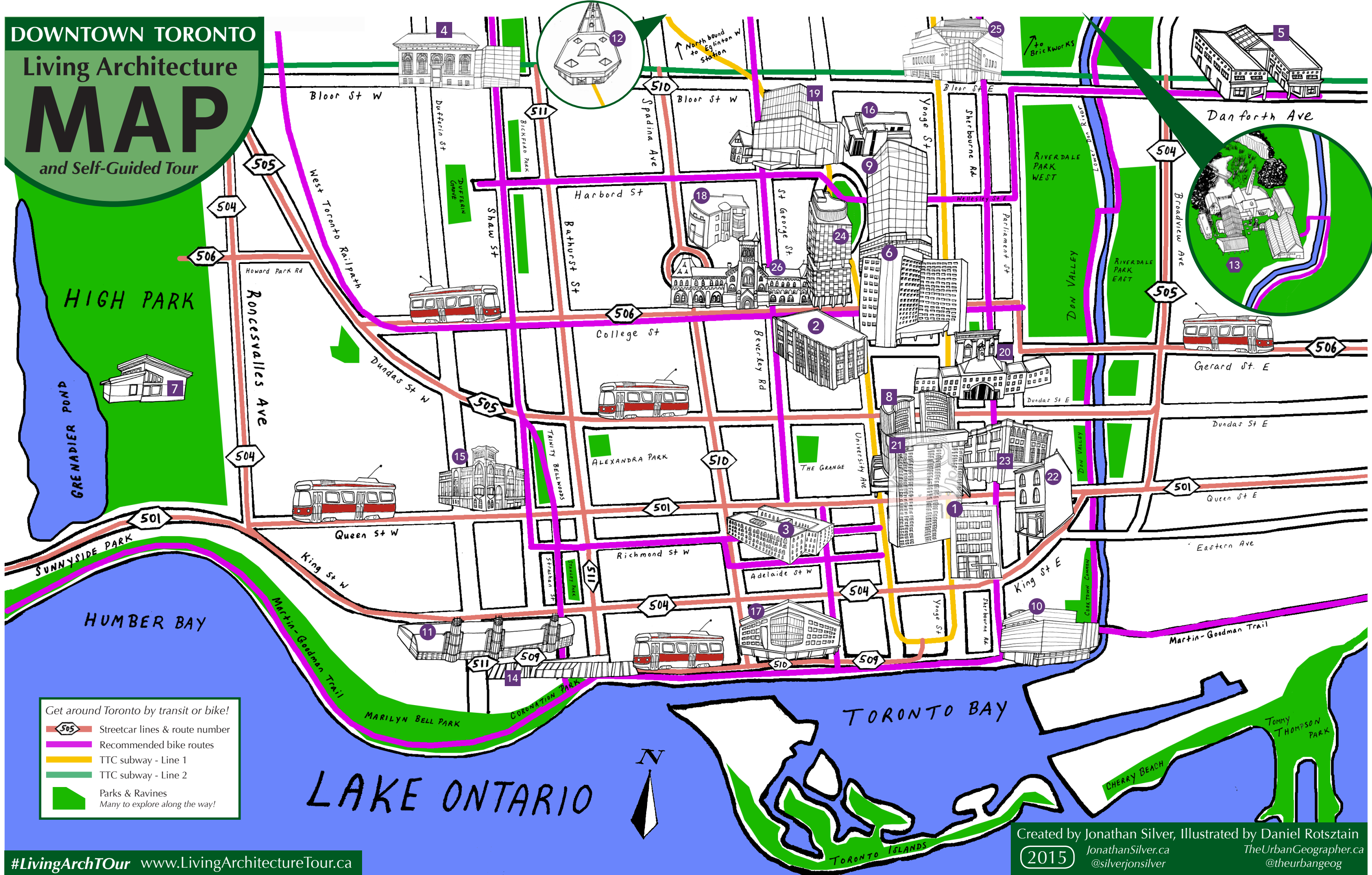

Many to explore along the way!

- 12 Eglinton West Station**
1300 Eglinton St. W
Interior (after paying fare)
Green roof is visible behind glass windows as you descend towards the subway platform.
Open during TTC's hours of operation
- 13 Evergreen Brickworks**
550 Bayview Ave.
Interior/Exterior
Go to Young Welcome Center and take elevator to 5th floor. If roof access is locked, ask for help at welcome desk. Wall is on ground floor located at staircase near welcome desk.
Open during regular business hours
- 14 Fort York National Historic Site**
250 Fort York Blvd
Exterior
Enter Visitor Center and speak to the welcome desk.
Open 10am-4pm
- 15 Gladstone Hotel**
1214 Queen St. W
Interior
Green wall and roof are visible when climbing main staircase.
Always open
- 16 Isabella Bader Theatre**
93 Charles St. W
Exterior
Vines are visible on west facade.
Always open
- 17 Longo's**
15 York St.
Interior
You can't miss it!
Open during regular business hours
- 18 Multifaith Center**
569 Spadina Ave.
Interior
Go to second floor and enter meditation room. Be silent as others may be meditating.
Open during regular business hours, weekdays only
- 19 Rotman School of Management**
105 St. George St.
Interior
Take elevator up to 5th floor and go onto patio. Another roof is visible from 4th floor.
Open during regular business hours, weekdays only
- 20 Ryerson Quad**
SW of Church St. and Gerrard St. E
Exterior
What appears to be a field is actually a green roof, which covers the gym below.
Open during regular business hours
- 21 Sheraton**
123 Queen St. W
Interior
Two-story courtyard garden with waterfall is visible on main floor. Accessible if door is unlocked.
Always open
- 22 Tandem Coffee**
368 King St. E
Interior
Sip an outstanding coffee next to a DIY green wall.
Open during regular business hours
- 23 Tangerine**
221 Yonge St.
Interior
Green roof is on main floor.
Open during regular business hours
- 24 Terrence Donnelly Center for Cellular and Biomolecular Research**
160 College St.
Interior
Indoor gardens on main floor. Please keep quiet as this is a research-focused building.
Open during regular business hours. Groups larger than 10 cannot visit.
- 25 Toronto Reference Library**
789 Yonge St.
Interior
A small living wall can be found next to the Bram & Bluma Appel Salon. Also, look for the idea garden.
Open during regular business hours
- 26 University College**
15 King's College Circle
Exterior
Vines can be seen on building's facade and surrounding buildings.
Always open

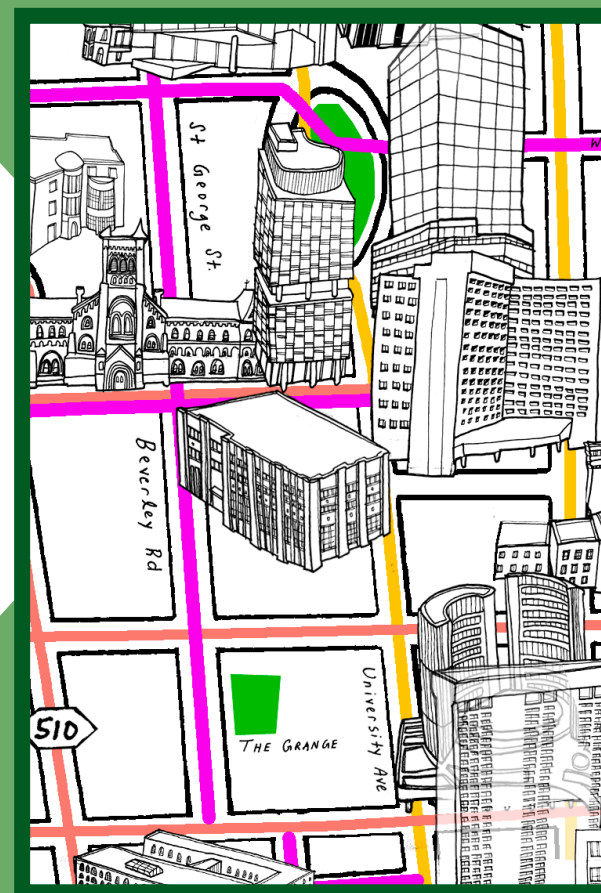

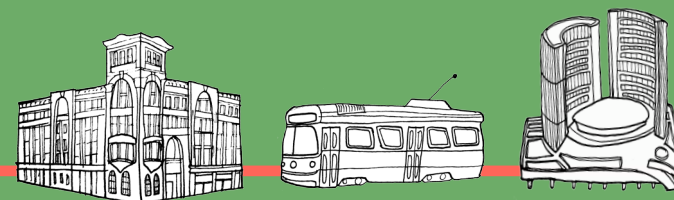

- 1 210 King Street East**
Interior
Wall is seen from front door.
Open during regular business hours
- 2 255 McCaul Street**
Interior
Wall is visible upon entering front door on McCaul St. Please keep quiet since this is an exam center. Avoid entering if people are gathered and waiting to enter an exam room.
Open during regular business hours
- 3 401 Richmond**
401 Richmond Street W
Exterior
Vines are visible along northern facade.
Always open
- 4 Bloor/Gladstone Library**
1101 Bloor St. W
Interior
Roof can be seen behind glass on 2nd floor, behind reference desk. Also, take a moment to enjoy the reading garden.
Open during regular business hours.
- 5 Carrot Common**
348 Danforth Ave
Exterior
Look for staircase leading up to green roof.
Open during regular business hours
- 6 Chelsea Hotel, Toronto**
33 Gerrard St. W
Interior
Wall is near concierge.
Always open
- 7 Children's Teaching Kitchen**
South central part of High Park
Exterior
Green roof can be seen if standing a few meters north of building.
Open during regular business hours
- 8 City Hall Podium**
100 Queen St. W
Exterior
Take stairs or ramp up to second level and walk on the largest green roof in Toronto.
Open during regular business hours
- 9 College Park**
777 Bay St.
Interior
Enter tall glass building. Turn left and keep walking. Green wall is down the hall to the left of the green grocery store.
Open during regular business hours
- 10 Corus Entertainment**
25 Dockside Dr.
Exterior
Five story green wall is only visible behind glass. A second wall inside the restaurant is visible from behind glass if the curtains happen to be drawn.
Always open
- 11 Direct Energy Centre**
100 Princes' Blvd.
Interior
Green wall is located at east end of building, near 'Hall D'.
Open during regular business hours
